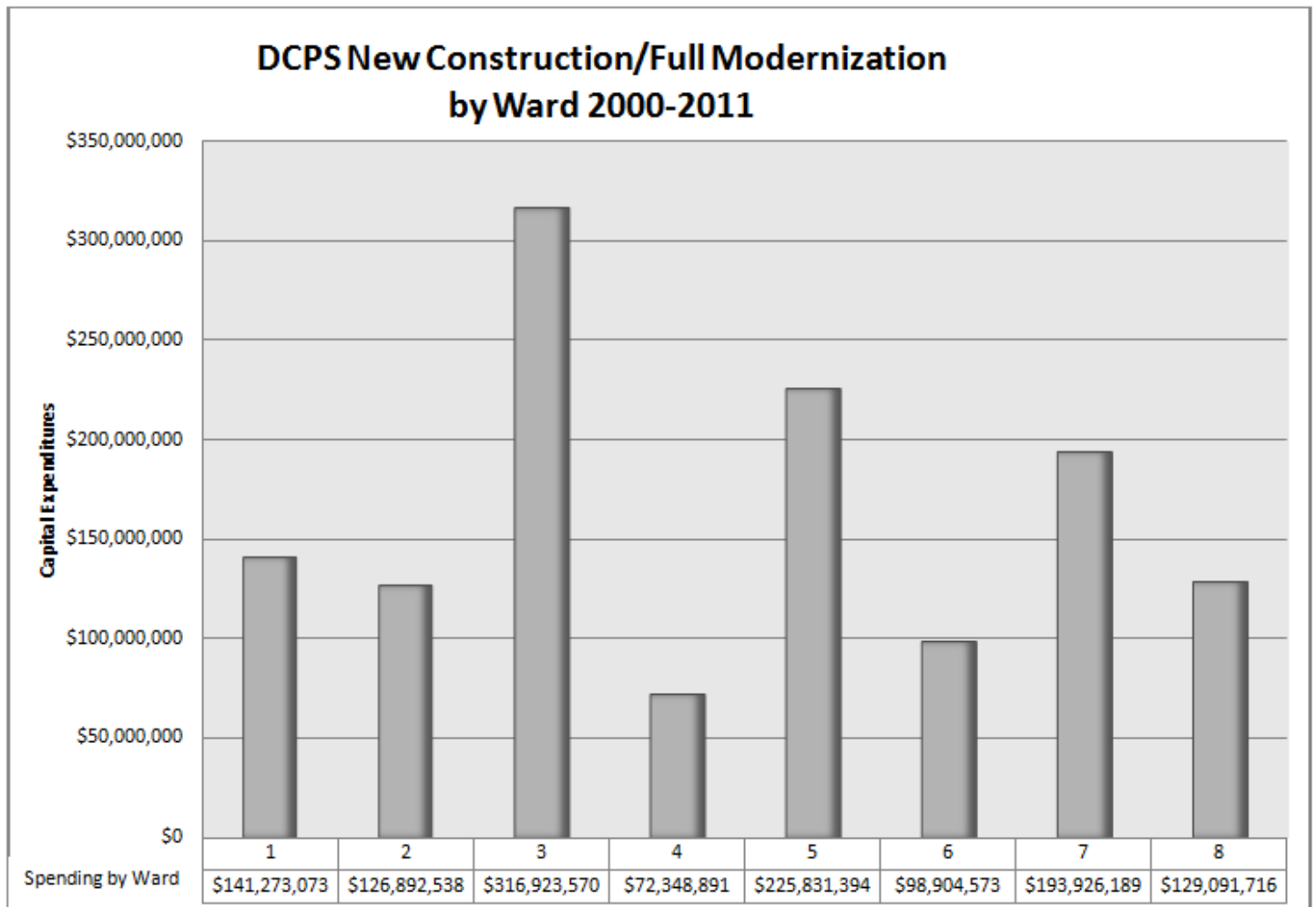


DCPS Overall Spending on New and Completely Modernized Schools 2000-2011

The bar graph below illustrates ward-by-ward spending on District of Columbia Public Schools' 32 new and fully modernized schools within the past decade. It does not include spending on stabilization, repair, small capital projects or phased modernizations.

On one hand the District should be applauded for a huge effort to catch up on decades of neglect and reaching for a vision of quality public schools. On the other hand it is distressingly clear that the city must better balance spending. More equitable investment should jump start civic vitality in neighborhoods where students are most in need of great school facilities with up-to-date technology and inviting outdoor environments.
