Eligibility: Heads of state-level education-facilities agencies, departments, offices, commissions, and authorities of a U.S. state, the District of Columbia, the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), the Department of Defense Education Activity (DODEA), Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, the Northern Mariana Islands, and American Samoa.

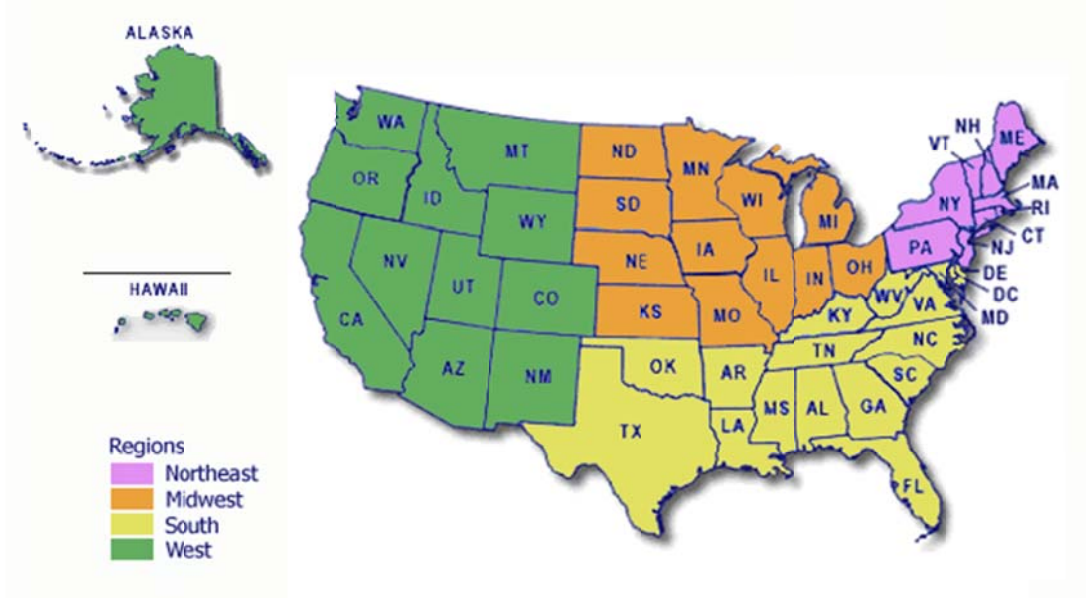
Each jurisdiction above has one vote, and must identify an agency head to serve as its Voting Member in the National Council.

The annual state assessment is \$5,000 per state. The assessment includes the Annual Meeting registration fee for the voting member.
