1995 – DC School Reform Act of 1995 passed by congress allows for the creation of public charter schools in the district. The D.C. Board of Education (DC BoE) is instituted as a state controlled charter school authorizer is created.

1996 – An amendment to the DC School Reform Act of 1995 allows for the creation of the Public Charter School Board (PCSB) a second, independent charter school authorizer.

1996 – The District's first charter schools open to a combined 160 students.

2006 – DC BoE votes to relinquish charter school authorizing responsibilities, making PCSB the sole charter school authorizer in the District.

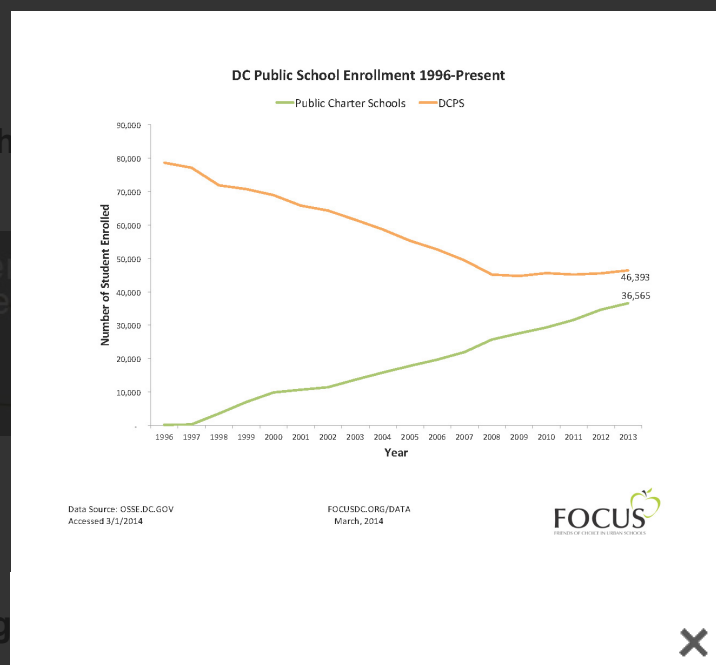
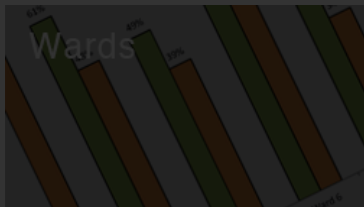
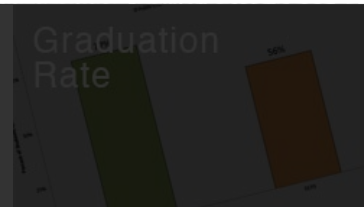
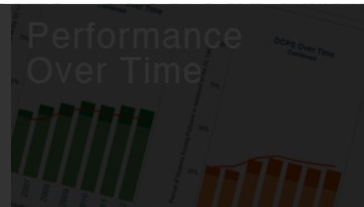
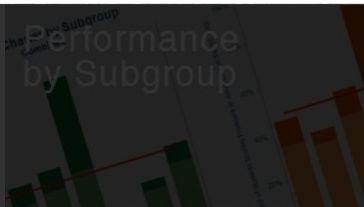

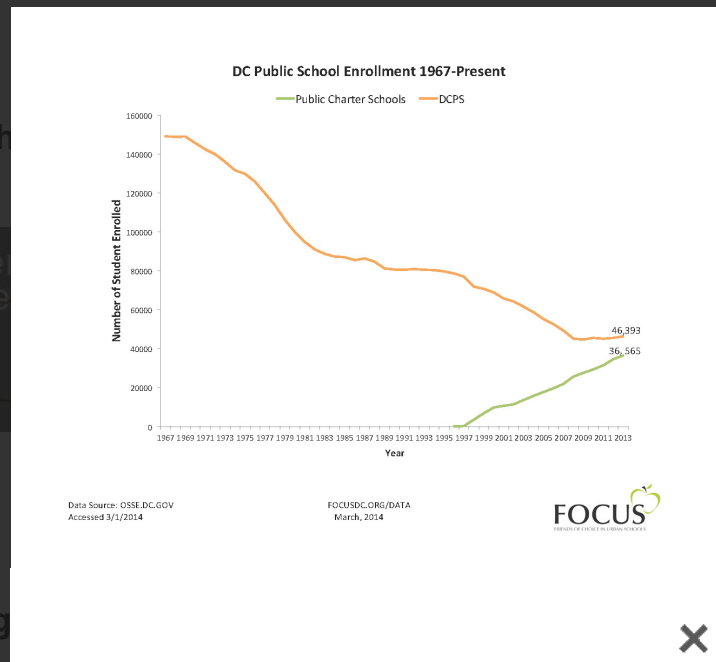
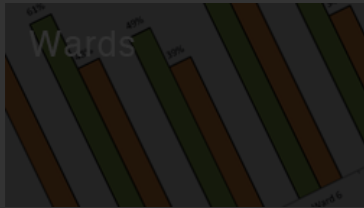
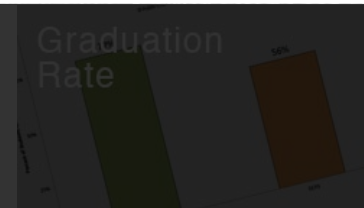
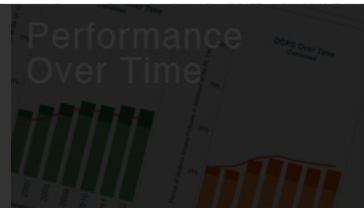
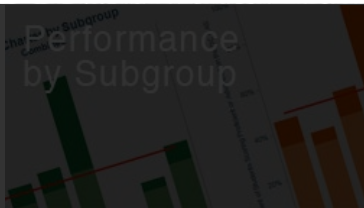


enrollment graph

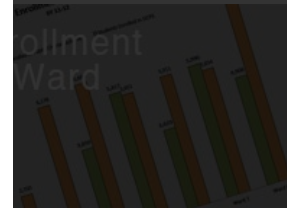
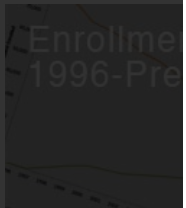
